2. What is your usual first response when you see behavior changes in your child? What is your reaction or response, as Teri Schroeder says, when your child shows “a lack of performance in school”?

3. Who are the people in your child’s school that you could turn to for support if you suspected your child was involved in cyberbullying in any way? What is your school’s policy on dealing with cyberbullying? How do you feel about the policy or the lack of a policy?

4. Teri closes by telling parents that when it comes to Internet safety with your children, “Just parent, y’know? Just get in there, help your kid, find out what’s going on, deal with the issue. And you want to not police them but protect them just like you would if it happened in real life.” What is the difference between life on the Internet and “real life”? How do you “just parent”?
